HURRICANE SEASON IS HERE:

Are you ready for hurricane season?

Check out these tips from the KBTX Weather Team to make sure you stay safe before, during, and after a storm:

KNOW THE TERMINOLOGY

Understand the different types of storms, watches, and warnings, as well as how to understand official forecasts.

UNDERSTAND THE RISKS

The Brazos Valley typically faces damaging winds, excessive rainfall, flooding, and even tornadoes from the storms' outer bands.

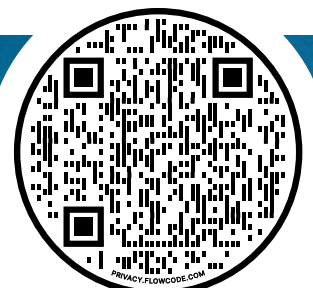


STAY INFORMED
