CAMPING SAFETY

Camping at Lake Bryan is a great weekend getaway right here in our own backyard! Just remember that electrical safety practices extend to RV's and traditional camping too. Follow these warnings to keep your trip fun and safe!

RV Camping



- When getting your RV set up at your camp site, you should always plug it directly into the provided outlet. Avoid extension cords.
- Whether you're using the provided electrical hookups or a generator, always know the amperage your RV draws. Trying to pull more electricity than is available can cause damage to both your RV and the electrical source, and can start a fire.
- Always know where your major switches and your electrical panel are in case of emergency.

Tent Camping



- Only use tent heaters, not lamps or stoves. These heaters should also only be used in tents designed for six or more people, and are well vented.
- Check that any extension cords, or other appliance cords, are in good condition and don't appear to be frayed.
- Don't overload extension cords. This can pose a fire hazard.
