With summertime in full swing, remember to practice **electrical safety** when you are enjoying a fun day at the pool, lake, or any other **body of water!** Here are a few tips to keep you, your family, and your friends safe:

- If you hear thunder, immediately exit the water. Lightning producing storms are nearby!
- Never bring electrical devices near water.
   If they come into contact with water, electric shock can occur. As a general rule of thumb, keep all electric powered items a minimum of ten feet away from water.
- Be sure all outdoor electrical outlets are covered to ensure they stay dry. Don't use an outlet if there is a possibility it is wet!
- When possible, use battery operated electrical devices when you are outside and near water.

# **Energy Conservation Tip:**

Make sure lamps, TVs, and other heat generating appliances aren't near thermostats.

These can trick your thermostat into thinking the room is hotter than it really is causing the system to spend extra energy cooling your home.





## **Water Conservation Tip:**

Dirty car? Go to the car wash! Washing your vehicle at home can use 100+ gallons of water versus the 40 gallons or less that is used by a commercial car wash.
