START OFF YOUR NEW YEAR WITH TWELVE ENERGY TIPS FOR 2019

January: Check your windows for air leaks—add weather stripping where leaks are present.

February: Replace your furnace filter monthly during the winter season.

March: Clean leaves and other plant debris away from your air conditioning unit.

April: Have your air conditioning unit serviced to ensure it is in good working order for the summer.

May: Consider making energy efficiency improvements that qualify for BTU's SmartHOME program. The application and description of each qualifying improvement are available at **btutilities.com**.

June: Invest in solar screens to keep the heat out of your home—solar screens block approximately 90% of the sun's rays.

July: Keep your thermostat set at 78 degrees or higher to reduce cooling costs. Remember to change your air filters monthly for optimal efficiency.

August: Use ceiling fans to help keep you cool rather than turning the air conditioner down.

September: Upgrade your light bulbs to LED—they use significantly less energy and put off less heat, reducing your cooling costs.

October: Water heating accounts for approximately 18% of the energy consumed in your home. If you have an electric water heater, consider turning it down to the "warm" setting (120 degrees).

November: Try using smaller appliances for cooking, such as a toaster oven or crockpot, rather than your oven to reduce the amount of energy you use.

December: Invest in LED Christmas lights! They last longer, don't put off as much heat, and will save you on your holiday utility bill.
