SmartHOME PROGRAM UPGRADING YOUR WINDOWS

Do you want to reduce your home's energy usage and save money this year? If so, it is a great time to participate in BTU's SmartHOME program, which incentivizes customers to make energy efficient changes to their home. By adding attic or wall insulation, installing solar screens, or upgrading old windows to Energy Star® rated windows you can earn between 10 and 25 percent of your project cost back.

Replacing windows is an improvement that customers can make to their home in order to be more energy efficient. Energy Star® rated windows help prevent heat gain from the sun during the summer and reduce heat loss in the winter. According to an Energy Star® study, replacing your windows could save you an average of 12 percent a year on energy bills.

In order to qualify, the upgraded windows must be Energy Star® certified for our area of Texas or you can purchase windows that are certified for all 50 states. Windows will have stickers or paperwork that depict a map to signify areas where the windows are certified. Only areas of permanent residential structures that are controlled by electric heat and air conditioning will qualify (mobile homes, porches, and non-air conditioned spaces do not qualify). 

When planting a new landscape, create areas with different hydro-zones depending on sun/shade exposure, soil and plant types, and type of sprinklers. Be sure to adjust your irrigation system or watering schedule based on those zones' specific needs. This helps you avoid overwatering some areas or under-watering others.
