WHY *Switch TO* LED LIGHTING?

Lighting accounts for over ten percent of the average household energy bill. LED lighting is up to 80 percent more efficient than traditional incandescent and fluorescent lighting; switching could save you money.

According to the Department of Energy, quality LED light bulbs can have a useful life of 25,000 hours or more, which is 25 times longer than traditional light bulbs. This is a lifespan of more than three years if run 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

LEDs emit very little energy as heat unlike incandescent and fluorescent lighting. This means they are more energy efficient and add less heat to your home.
