IMPROVE YOUR HOME

with Energy-Efficient Upgrades

Since 2002, May has become known as National Home Improvement Month. This year, consider improving your home by adding insulation to your attic or exterior walls, replacing old single-pane windows with Energy Star® certified windows, or adding solar screens to your existing windows. All three of these home improvements fall under BTU's SmartHOME program, which means you may qualify to receive a 10%-25% incentive check.

To qualify for the SmartHOME incentives, the customer must be the owner of single- or multi-family permanent dwelling in the BTU service area. Before and after pictures of the improvements are required, and rebate percentages are calculated based on the estimated average kilowatt savings of the improvements.

Attic/Exterior Wall Insulation

The attic and wall insulation incentive is based on an increase of insulation effectiveness, which is measured in R-values. An insulation project qualifies if your home's attic has an existing R-value of less than R-22 and insulation is added to raise the value to R-30 or higher. For wall insulation to qualify, the exterior walls must not have any existing insulation and must be raised to R-13 or higher.

Energy Star® Windows

Energy Star® certified windows help prevent heat gain from the sun during the summer and reduce heat loss in the winter. Replacing your existing single pane windows with Energy Star® certified windows could save you an average of 12 percent a year on energy bills. In order to qualify, the upgraded windows must be Energy Star® certified for our area of Texas or you can purchase windows that are certified for all 50 states.

Solar Screens

Solar screens are made to reflect the sun's rays to reduce solar heat gain, ultraviolet light damage, and glare. Adding solar screens to your east and west facing windows can block at least 65% of the sun's ultraviolet rays entering your home. By reducing the solar heat gain in your home, your air conditioner won't have to work as hard to cool the house.
