SET CHRISTMAS AND EXTERIOR LIGHTING ON A TIMER TO SAVE ENERGY AND WARD OFF POTENTIAL THIEVES

TURN YOUR WATER HEATER TO "VACATION" MODE OR SET TO THE LOWEST SETTING IF IT DOES NOT HAVE VACATION MODE



SET YOUR THERMOSTAT TO 62°F OR LOWER WHILE YOU ARE AWAY



TURN OFF ALL CEILING AND STAND FANS
