Energy-efficient windows prevent heat gain in summer and reduce heat loss in winter. To qualify, ensure upgraded windows are Energy Star[®] certified for our Texas area or certified for all 50 states. Only permanent residential structures with electric heat and air conditioning qualify (mobile homes, porches, and non-air-conditioned spaces are excluded).

Energy-Efficient Window Diagram

FRAME

Reduce heat transfer and insulate better by using durable, quality framing materials.

MULTIPLE PANES

Two panes of glass, filled with air or gas between each pane, insulate better than a single pane of glass. Energy efficiency increases with three or more panes of glass.

LOW-E GLASS

Infrared light is reflected using special coatings, which keep heat inside during winter and heat outside in the summer.

GAS FILLS

Non-toxic gases, such as argon and krypton, fill the space between the panes to increase energy efficiency and insulate.

SPACERS

Spacers are used to achieve the proper distance between the panes of glass, insulate pane edges, and reduce heat transfer.

CONSERVATION TIPS

Energy Conservation Tip:

If you have an electric heat pump, avoid making drastic increases to your thermostat settings. Only increase the temperature setting by two degrees at a time to avoid triggering auxiliary heat, which uses a great amount of energy.

Water Conservation Tip:

To lower the risk of water leaks due to freezing temperatures, cover exposed pipes and hose bibs with pipe insulation.
