Avoid overloading outlets and use surge protectors.



Keep electrical appliances away from water sources and never touch outlets with wet hands.



Install tamper-resistant outlets and keep cords out of reach.



Save energy and reduce fire risk by unplugging devices when not in use.



Learn how to safely reset circuit breakers, GCFI outlets, and replace fuses. When in doubt, consult an electrician.



For complex electrical work, hire a licensed electrician.
